Examination Pattern

1) Each question paper will carry 150 Marks and will be of one & half hour's duration.

2) Each question paper will consist of 75 questions of 2 marks each.

6) Answer recorded in any other form will not be considered such answer will be marked 'zero' eg:- ✕ ② ● ●

7) While recording the correct options in the answer sheet use only black or blue ball pen. Answers recorded with pencil will not be considered.

8) For the preparation of examination in Language, the students are advised to cultivate the habit of reading books recommended by teachers or parents besides their textbooks.

9) For the preparation of examination in Mathematics, the students are advised to solve as many examples as possible. This will enhance their speed and ensure accuracy.

10) For the preparation of examination in IT the students are advised to make a thorough study of the concerned problems and solve as many question papers as possible.

1) The Exam Will Be Held On The Second Last Sunday In The Month Of January.

2) Last Date Of Submission Of Application Form Is 14th August. After 15th August Late Fees Of ₹ 100 Will Be Charged.

3) Scholarship Will Be Given To Each State Level Merit Holder For 1 Time Only.

4) Examination Fees Is Non Refundable & It Is Not Transferable.

5) Examination Centers Will Be Allocated In Each And Every District / Taluka Provided The Number Of Students Is 200 In Each Center. If Center Facility Is Not Available In That Area, Then Student Have To Travel At The Nearest Center At His Own Expenses.

6) The Merit List Depends On The Number Of Students Participating Overall.

7) The Maharashtra Pradnya Shodh Pariksha Reserves The Right Of The Number Of Merit List.

8) The Form Should Be Submitted Through Schools Or Through Authorised Area Coordinators Only Or At Pune Office.

9) The Examination Fees Should Be Submitted Through Schools Or Can Be Paid Through Cheque / DD Drawn On Maharashtra Pradnya Shodh Pariksha At Mumbai. Cheque / DD Is Applicable Only For Students Appearing Privately.
